



Better Biomass Tariff sheet 2023

The tariffs for certificate holders consist of an annual fee for each certificate and an annual membership fee or annual payment per metric ton.

Annual fee per certificate

This is the annual fee for the certificate holder, which is collected by the certification body on behalf of the scheme manager.

^a In case of group certification of small-holders, the group is classified as a 'Producer primary biomass > 250 ha'.

Annual membership fee

Companies that intend to certify according to NTA 8080 need to register at NEN. Members are exempt from payment per metric ton and registration costs, and receive membership benefits.

^b It concerns the annual turnover of the legal entity (the company) that wishes to register. In the case of group certification of smallholders, the group is considered the legal entity.

Payment per metric ton

Companies can also choose for a payment of € 0,0312 per metric ton (with a minimum total of € 100). The company has the obligation to inform NEN about the volume of sustainable biomass under certificate. These details have to be submitted during the auditing process or once a year (within 12 months after the last audit).

The above prices do not include VAT and are valid until 31 December 2023.
